## Nick Rose - Author's Visit

## **Dear Teacher**

Thank you for inviting me to your school. On the afternoon of my visit, I will be giving two approx 40mins performances in your main hall using a Power Point Presentation with your hall computer and projector.

I will then be selling and signing books in the playground at the reduced price of £5 each (normally £7).

At the end of each performance, I run a 5-10min Q&A session with the children, which they enjoy more if they have learned about Myro in the days before I come.

The best way to introduce Myro is to use the **Myro English Teaching Kit**, which contains a book and a CD-ROM full of teacher's resources. If you do not have access to this kit, then go to <a href="https://www.myro.com/visit">www.myro.com/visit</a> where you can download some of the resources for free.

## Reception, Years 1 and 2

This first performance is a bit like a pantomime, with lots of audience participation. I introduce Myro and then read the book "Myro & the Jet Fighter", before the Q&A session. *To prepare, may I suggest the following:* 

- Explain about authors and how one is coming to visit them
- Show the video "Myro Arrives in Australia"
- Work through the "Myro Interactive Power Point" presentation with them
- For Reception, print out the "Myro Colouring-in Sheet"
- For Years 1 & 2, print out the "Myro Story Worksheets" for group work
- Prepare asking questions for the Author: How, What, When, Why & Who

## Years 3, 4 and 5

The second performance is much more grown-up talk, where I explain how I became an author, and how I developed the books, the iPad apps and the TV series. *To prepare, may I suggest the following:* 

- Explain how author Nick Rose is coming to visit them
- Research "Myro" and "Nick Rose" on the internet
- In groups or individually, get the children to explore the interactive Power Point presentation
- Print out "Myro Story Worksheets" and in groups, work out why the author chose the story direction
- Listen to the "Nick Rose Radio Interview"
- Prepare questions for the Author, and make them tough and interesting!
